1. STATEMENT

Maritime Transport Ltd (MTL) recognises that by the nature of its business activities it has an impact on the environment. - Ensure the fleet continue to meet the highest standard of performance in order to reduce carbon emissions
- Reduce the consumption of fossil fuels and other non renewable natural resources
- Work towards achieving Net Zero in greenhouse gas emissions by 2050, by committing to Science based targets, ESOS and SECR
- Ensure that the Environmental Strategy Group works towards the defined Sustainable Development Goals
- Minimise any significant adverse environmental impacts of new developments and ensure continued progress towards sustainable development
- Introduce energy conservation measures at current depots and work towards the procurement of 100% renewable energy by the end of 2023
- Minimise the production of waste and apply the waste management hierarchy, minimising the use of landfill
- MTL is committed to the prevention of littering both at its own premises and the surrounding areas and expects all staff and external parties such as suppliers, contractors and stakeholders to commit to not littering and report litter to relevant authorities.
- Ensure environmental and sustainability considerations are given to purchasing decision making and progress is made towards purchasing items having fewer environmental impacts
- Prepare and monitor environmental objectives and targets with the aim of continual improvement
- Provide information and training to employees to ensure an efficient response to an incident or emergency that may have an impact on the environment
- Communicate with employees and stakeholders on environmental matters and promote a positive culture in relation to conserving and enhancing the environment


The Risk & Compliance Department will be responsible for the introduction, monitoring and promotion of the policy and the objectives.
